





Building Better Communities, Together High Construction provided preconstruction and construction management services for this award-winning transformation of Landis Homes' campus in Lititz, PA. Demolition of nine existing cottage buildings containing 30 homes began in 2016 to make way for the new three-wing facility. At the hub, a 101,000 square foot, four-story building houses all learning and wellness activities as well as 22 apartment units. Flanking the left and right sides of the center facility are two three-story wings, one spanning 30,000 square feet with 33 apartment units and the other spanning 42,000 square feet with 27 apartment units.

Project & Client Background

About Landis Homes

Located in Lancaster County, Pa., Landis Homes is a not-for-profit retirement community that has served seniors for more than 50 years. The community offers retirement living, adult day services, and a home care agency. More than 850 people live on the 114-acre campus, in cottages, apartments, and suites.

About the Learning & Wellness Center and Crossings Apartments

The new Learning & Wellness Center and Crossings Apartments are located in the heart of Landis Homes' campus. The new facilities provide a "front door" to the existing senior living community, replacing several older cottages that were located on the site. At the hub, the four-story Learning and Wellness Center building features a pool, exercise space, bistro, salon, pharmacy, bank, auditorium, and a classroom. Apartments are also located in the Center, as well as in the two three-story wings, adjacent to the Center. All 79 of the "hybridized" apartments—which are much more livable than a traditional apartment design—were sold before construction was completed.
